

# ALABAMA CAMP GUIDELINES

- 1) All campers must register to stay at camp. Those under 18 years of age must have their registration form signed by their parent and/or guardian. All campers must have their form signed by their pastor.
- 2) All individuals of camper age staying on the campgrounds must register as a camper and reside in the dorms.
- 3) All registered campers must attend all scheduled activities.
- 4) Except for Camp Meeting, all individuals participating in any service, class, or activity, except the 7 P.M. (Crusader Camp) and 7:30 P.M. (Youth Camp) service, must be registered.
- 5) No dangerous articles such as guns or knives shall be permitted. Shrink-wrap and similar items are forbidden. Possession of these articles may result in immediate expulsion from camp.
- 6) No solicitation will be allowed other than that by the District Departments and guest ministries. The Camp Administrator must approve all solicitation.
- 7) The dorm areas shall be secured and supervised at all times.
- 8) No unmarried couples shall be together without supervision while on campus. Inappropriate physical contact between male and female campers is forbidden.
- 9) Camp officials reserve the right to ask any individual who refuses to attend the evening services or cooperate with any other aspect of camp policy to immediately leave the campgrounds.
- 10) Any individual expelled from any camp shall not be permitted to attend any other camp in the same calendar year without the approval of the Camp Administrator of the camp from which he was expelled, the District Superintendent, and upon recommendation by his pastor.
- 11) Guidelines for personal appearance for registered campers:
  - A) All clothing must be modest.
    - 1) All dresses, shirts, and blouses must have sleeves.
    - 2) For females, dresses and skirts must cover the knees. Pants, culottes, and shorts are not acceptable.
    - 3) For males, pants must be full length. Shorts are not acceptable.
    - 4) Necklines should be modest. Transparent or semi-transparent clothing is prohibited.
    - 5) Shirts must be modest with no logo that supports anti-Christian values.
  - B) Appearance should be godly.
    - 1) For males, the hair should be trimmed nicely, not covering one's ears or collar. Mustaches and beards are forbidden.
    - 2) For females, the hair should be neatly kept.
    - 3) Makeup and jewelry are prohibited.
- 12) Guidelines for behavior for registered campers:
  - A) No tobacco in any form shall be allowed.
  - B) Only prescription drugs are allowed on campus. For the Youth Camp and Crusader Camp these must be registered with the camp nurse and administered with supervision.
  - C) Water pistols, any radios or other media players, and other disruptive items are forbidden.
  - D) At Youth Camp no camper shall have the keys to a vehicle in his possession. They must be turned in upon registration.
  - E) All campers must attend all required functions unless excused by their Dorm Supervisor.
- 13) No individuals who are married shall be permitted to register as campers at Youth Camp.
- 14) No unauthorized handling of sound equipment or musical instruments is allowed.
- 15) At Youth Camp and Crusader Camp no camper shall be permitted to check out and/or leave the grounds without written permission from his/her parent or guardian.
- 16) The Camp Administrators reserve the right to check all registered campers for head lice.
- 17) Only campers residing more than 100 miles from the camp grounds will be allowed to stay over night on Friday. All other campers must check out and depart after the Friday Evening service. The facilities will be closed and vacated by 10 A.M. on Saturday.
